## **YEAR 12 ACTIVITIES**

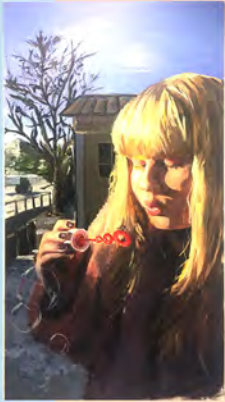

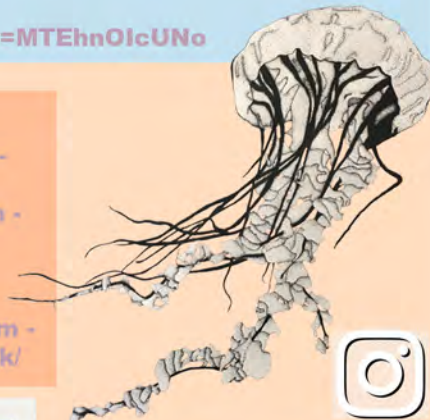
